

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approval to Transfer the New Detention Facility to the Bureau of Indian Affairs)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, a new detention facility has been constructed by the White Mountain Apache Tribe via a Public Law 93-638 Construction contract and a Certificate of Occupancy has been issued by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Office of Facilities Management; and

WHEREAS, the new detention facility is a total replacement of the Bureau of Indian Affairs owned old detention center (Building No. 84); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to have the Bureau of Indian Affairs take title of the new Detention Facility, including the care, safety and maintenance of the building; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to transfer the new detention facility to BIA.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby transfers the detention facility to the Bureau of Indian Affairs and that they shall have full responsibility for the care, safety and maintenance of the new detention facility, which will be occupied by the Detention Services Program contracted by the Tribe via a Public Law 93-638 Contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>SEPTEMBER 13, 2010</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (h), (j), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
