



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing a Revolving Credit Loan to Dorthea Ivins)

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has been advised that tribal employee, Dorthea Ivins husband passed away; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council extends its sincere sympathy to Dorthea Ivins and her family; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council approves to support and assist Dorthea Ivins by authorizing the Revolving Credit Program to provide Mrs. Ivins with a \$2,000.00 loan; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that such support and assistance is consistent with and pursuant to the Apache way, and is in the best interest of the Tribe and the Ivins family.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Revolving Credit Program to provide Dorthea Ivins with a loan in the amount of \$2,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event of any inconsistency between this Resolution and any prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on SEPTEMBER 29, 2010, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
