

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Rescinding Resolution 10-2010-262)

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Rose Marie and Rose Mary Quintero did approach the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and request assistance; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council did pass *Resolution 10-2010-262*, directing the Legal Department to represent Ms. Quintero or to use its budget to hire outside counsel to represent her; and

WHEREAS, complying with this resolution would create an irreconcilable conflict for the WMAT Legal Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds that it should rescind the resolution.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution 10-2010-262: Directing the Legal Department to Assist Rose Marie Quintero.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on OCTOBER 7, 2010 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (d), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
