

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Brian Peaches to Receive Annual Leave Transfer from Tribal Employees)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, tribal employee and tribal member Mr. Floyd Peaches, requests to donate 120 hours of annual leave to his brother, Brian Peaches; and

WHEREAS, other tribal employees have also expressed a desire to donate annual leave hours; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brian Peaches is an employee of the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Fire and Rescue Department and was placed on medical leave in September, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brian Peaches and his family have suffered greatly from being on leave for medical purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of Brian Peaches and the Tribe to help during this time of need by allowing Brian Peaches to receive annual leave transfers from tribal employees.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes two hundred and forty (240) annual leave hours to be transferred to Brian Peaches due to medical obligations and authorizes the process of a supplemental.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>DECEMBER 13, 2010</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
