

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Navajo County Public Health Services to Provide Oral Health Varnish to Children Ages Birth to Five)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 06-2008-133 allows for the establishment of the First Things First White Mountain Apache Tribe Regional Partnership Council and all duties that pertain to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Regional Partnership Council; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Partnership Council identified dental disease prevention among children ages birth to five a priority for the Region; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Partnership Council awarded a grant to the Navajo County Public Health Services Department to implement a dental varnish program in order to help prevent dental disease among young children; and

WHEREAS, the First Things First White Mountain Apache Tribe Regional Partnership Council is requesting permission for the Navajo County Public Health Services Department to be allowed to begin implementation of all components related to the oral health program for all children ages birth through five residing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to authorize the Navajo County Public Health Services Department to implement a dental varnish program for all children ages birth through five residing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Navajo County Public Health Services Department be allowed to implement all elements of the oral health program funded through the First Things First White Mountain Apache Tribe Regional Partnership Council.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
