

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approval of Tribal Transportation Priority List)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the WMAT Transportation Committee duly appointed by the Tribal Council is authorized to advise and recommend to the Tribal Council in all policy and program matters related to the Indian Reservation Roads Program, bridges, roads and highways within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, byways and trails; and other inter-modal initiatives for the benefit of the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the WMAT Transportation Committee is further authorized to interact, meet, and represent the Tribe in such matters with outside agencies such as the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Federal Highway Administration, Arizona Department of Transportation; also local, state, federal governments and other transportation groups, associations, and committees concerning transportation policies, procedures and funding related to but not limited to 25 CFR 170 et. seq. regarding primary rules, regulations and federal funding initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Transportation Committee requests that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approve the following priority for Transportation projects on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation:

- 1. Develop Policy and Procedures for the Tribal Transportation Committee
- 2. Hawley Lake Campgrounds Roads: drainage improvement and gravel surface.
- 3. Detention Center Road: pave, grade and drainage
- 4. Rick Lupe Road: pave, grade and drainage
- 5. Long Range Transportation Plan Update (inventory, traffic counts, etc)
- 6. Trail Projects for the following locations:
 - a. Hospital South: asphalt/concrete 6 feet wide
 - b. N Tenijeth Ave: asphalt/concrete 6 feet wide
 - c. N 1st, 2nd, 3rd and W Sycamore St: asphalt/concrete 6 feet wide
 - d. HWY 73 (existing walkways) to WR Commercial Center: asphalt/concrete 6 feet wide
 - e. Ft. Apache Jct. to WR Commercial Center: asphalt/concrete 6 feet wide
 - f. FATCO Jct. at HWY 73 to East Fork Road (BIA 44 Road): asphalt/concrete 6 feet wide

WHEREAS, the establishment of a priority list for transportation projects will facilitate the achievement of transportation goals for the Tribe and communicate to the BIA the Tribe's priorities; and

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WHEREAS, the transportation Committee requests that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approve the priority list as set out above.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that hereby approves the priority list for transportation projects on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all document necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MARCH 16, 2011 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
