

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Honoring the Late West Anderson)

WHEREAS, the Anderson family addressed the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") on this date, to request that the Tribe provide financial assistance to their family for the burial of the late West Anderson; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has acknowledged the former Councilman's service to the Tribal community and sends its condolences to the Anderson family on the loss of their loved one; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the merits of providing financial assistance to the Anderson family, despite cost containment measures that are currently in effect; and

WHEREAS, for the reason stated above, Councilman Clinton Kessay, Jr., District II, agreed to pay for the cost of cement, and the Vice-Chairman shall pay for the flagpole; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Anderson family and the greater Tribe, to encourage members of the Tribal Council to voluntarily contribute \$500.00 to assist the family with the cost of the headstone.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby sends its condolences to the Anderson family and encourages the Tribal Council to contribute a donation of five hundred dollars to assist the Anderson family with the cost of the headstone for the late West Anderson.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JUNE 1, 2011</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
