

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Community Dental Mobile Clinic)

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Division of Health Programs recognizes the need to improve oral health services for its White Mountain Apache Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Division of Health is committed to promoting education and treating dental health at an early age; and
- WHEREAS, the Community Dental Mobile Clinic provides mobile dental services to disadvantaged children in underserved areas regardless of whether or not they have dental insurance; and
- WHEREAS, the Division of Health Programs and the Community Dental Mobile Clinic are working in collaboration to improve oral health among tribal members living on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Community Dental Mobile Unit is requesting permission to bring its dental program that will provide dental exams, cleaning, sealants, and fillings; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to authorize this effort to provide dental care services on the reservation.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Division of Health to coordinate with the Community Dental Mobile clinic to provide dental services to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JUNE 06, 2011</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
