Resolution No. 01-2013-13

(Reinstating Radio Report Schedule for Tribal Council)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") is entrusted by the Tribe's Constitution to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, and to regulate subordinate organizations for economic and other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Governing Body has discussed and agrees that it is essential to implement a weekly radio report schedule on the KNNB radio station, as was previously the practice of the Tribe prior to the imposed moratorium due to the elections and the follow-up Resolution that sought to permanently alter the Tribal Council's rotation to take place on a weekly basis; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that members of the Tribe are fully informed by their Tribal Council representatives and to support the exchange of ideas and encourage public discourse on issues that highly impact the Tribe, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to reauthorize KNNB to reassume weekly radio reports for Tribal Council members, consistent with the following schedule:

Monday - Friday: Council and Vice-Chairman
Tuesdays: Chairman

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs KNNB to provide airtime for each member of the Tribal Governing Body. Tribal Council members and the Vice-Chairman shall share a regular rotation to take place daily from Monday through Friday. The Tribal Chairman shall issue his radio report as usual, on Tuesday afternoons.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, this Resolution shall be declared null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Acting Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. In the event that the Chairman fails to delegate signatory authority to an Acting Chairman, the Vice-Chairman may sign.

The foregoing resolution was on JANUARY 2, 2013 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (r), (s), (t) and (u) of the Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
