

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Nation Exercising Self-Governance Over the Fort Apache Indian Reservation

## **Resolution No. 02-2013-42**

(Authorizing Pow Wow in Cedar Creek to take place simultaneously with Pow Wow in the Pines at Hon-Dah)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") listened to concerns from Tribal Council representative Kino Kane on the community interest within District II to have a Pow Wow event scheduled during the same weekend as the Pow Wow in the

Pines event at Hon-Dah; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after much deliberation, has decided that it would be in the community and Tribe's best interest to honor this request, with District I Representative Gregg Henry in the affirmative provided that the Cibecue 4<sup>th</sup> of July event is not interfered with and that no other events are authorized within a 50 mile radius.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes District II to conduct a Pow Wow during the same weekend as the Hon-dah Pow Wow in the pines. The 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration, however, may not have a competing event anywhere within 50 miles of the town of Cibecue.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, this Resolution shall be declared null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Acting Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. In the event that the Chairman fails to delegate signatory authority to an Acting Chairman, the Vice-Chairman may sign.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 21, 2013</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
