A Sovereign Nation Exercising Self-Governance Over the Fort Apache Indian Reservation

Resolution No. 04-2013-91

(Accepting Report and Financial Status Update from Theodore Roosevelt School)

WHEREAS, Theodore Roosevelt School ("TRS") officials presented to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") a general and financial status report; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe acknowledges and commends the TRS for its continued commitment to the children residing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation that are able to take advantage of the school's offerings; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the Tribe's best interest to accept the general and financial status report as presented by the Theodore Roosevelt School Principal.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby acknowledges receipt of the general and financial report as presented by the Theodore Roosevelt School Principle and recognizes TRS for its dedication to White Mountain Apache Tribal members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, this Resolution shall be declared null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Acting Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. In the event that the Chairman fails to delegate signatory authority to an Acting Chairman, the Vice-Chairman may sign.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>APRIL 24, 2013</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
