



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Anna Goseyun as Juvenile Court Judge and Removing Sitting Juvenile Judge Lena Tenijieth)

WHEREAS, upon expiration of her term in October 2007, Lena Tenijieth, was asked to continue serving as Juvenile Judge pending the Tribal Council's selection of a new judge to carry out a four year term pursuant to the Judicial Code; and

WHEREAS, after some discussion and deliberation, the Tribal Council believes that it is time to refresh the court and though numerous candidates were considered, the Council finds it in the Tribe's best interest to appoint Anna Goseyun to fill the vacancy that will be left by Lena Tenijieth, whose term has expired; and

WHEREAS, Anna Goseyun's should be subject to a ninety (90) day probationary period and may not be formally seated until such time that a background check has been completed and Goseyun cleared and eligible to serve as a judicial officer of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Anna Goseyun as Juvenile Judge, pending the results of a full background check, and subject to a 90 day probationary period upon determination that she is eligible to serve as a Tribal Court Judge on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby excuses Juvenile Judge Lena Tenijieth, who termed out in 2007 and has served many years beyond what is expected under the Judicial Code.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.


