



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program)

WHEREAS, Congress has authorized funds for federal-aid highways, highway safety programs, transit programs, and for other purposes under MAP-21 (*Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century*), wherein the Tribal Transportation Program (TTP), which are administered by both the Federal Lands Highways Administration and the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to Final Rules established in 25 CFR Part 170; and

WHEREAS, the BIA-Western Regional Office (WRO), Division of Transportation (DOT), has provided the Tribe with Tribal Shares Reports identifying its portion of 2013 Indian Reservation Roads Program (IRRP) carryover funds, 2013 Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) carryover funds, 2014 Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) funds and their estimated share of TTP Funds for 2015 through 2017; and

WHEREAS, the WMAT Transportation Committee has been appointed and authorized by the Tribal Council to interact, meet, and represent the Tribe in such matters with outside agencies such as the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT); and other transportation groups and associations concerning transportation policies, procedures and funding related to, but not limited to 25 CFR 170 (et. Seq.), and to make recommendations to the Tribal Council regarding the scheduling of transportation planning and improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Committee has recommended to the Tribal Council a Priority Listing of Projects, and the Tribal Council has accepted these recommendations and enacted White Mountain Apache Tribal Resolution No. 06-2010-137; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, in consultation with the BIA-Division of Transportation has developed, from the Priority Listing of Projects identified in Tribal Resolution No. 06-2010-137, the attached 2014 – 2017 Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) that identifies transportation and improvement projects to be funded with the Tribe's share of FY 2013 IRRP and TTP carryover funds and 2014 – 2017 TTP funds; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby recommended that the Tribal Council approve the attached 2014-2017 Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) and authorize the BIA-WRO DOT to utilize a portion of their share of 2014 TTP funding to perform preconstruction activities and prepare Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) for the following projects, using the funding amounts identified in the attached Tribal TIP:

H5234300 - FAIR 101(1), Whiteriver Streets

H5234400 - FAIR 102(2), Horseshoe Drive (aka Rick Lupe Rd)

H5231100 - FAIR 104(1), Whiteriver Streets

H5234500 - FAIR 420 (1) Detention Center Road

WHEREAS, it is also recommended that the Tribal Council requests that the BIA provide FY 2013 and FY 2014 TTP funding to the Tribe in new P.L. 92-638 contracts/grants or amendments to existing P.L. 93-638 contracts/grants, in the amounts shown below, for the following projects:

H5241000 – FAIR SR73 (2) Frontage Road: 2013 TTP carryover funds in the amount of \$372,744.24, and 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$427,255.76. for the total amount of \$800,000.00 for a new P.L. 93-638 contract to enter into an agreement with ADOT for the design and construction of a 1mile frontage road in Canyon Day.

H5224200 – FAIR SR73 (3) Pedestrian Crossing: 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 for a new P.L. 93-638 to enter into an agreement with ADOT to provide Pedestrian Crossings on SR 73 at three locations in the Community of Whiteriver.

H5283100 – FAIR Trails Scoping Study: 2013 TTP funds in the amount of \$40,000.00, and 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$10,000.00, for a total amount of \$50,000.00 for a new P.L. 93-638 contract to conduct public meetings, perform preliminary surveys, and evaluate alignments for proposed trails and walkways to be designed and constructed under FAIR Safety No.1.

H5289400 – FAIR Tribal Transportation Planning No. 3: 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$250,000.00 are to be added to existing P.L. 93-638 Planning Grant No. A12AV01358, for additional staff, office space, and equipment, to provide transportation planning assistance and services needed to support a tribal transportation program.

H52RM607 – FAIR Roads Maintenance: 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$200,000.00 is to be made available for use by the BIA Fort Apache Agency Branch of Roads to perform routine road maintenance activities identified in Appendix A to Subpart G of 25 CFR 170; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached 2014 – 2017 Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) and authorizes the BIA – WRO DOT to utilize a portion of their share of 2014 TTP funding to perform preconstruction activities and prepare Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) for the following projects, using the funding amounts identified, in the attached Tribal TIP:

H5231100 – FAIR 104(1), Whiteriver Streets
H5234300 – FAIR 101(1), Whiteriver Streets
H5234400 – FAIR 102(2), Horseshoe Drive (aka Rick Lupe Road)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the BIA provide FY 2013 & FY 2014 TTP funding to the Tribe in new P.L. 93-638 contracts/grants or amendments to existing P.L. 93-638 contract/grants, in the amounts shown below, for the following projects:

H5241000 – FAIR SR73 (2) Frontage Road: 2013 TTP carryover funds in the amount of \$372,744.24, and 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$427,255.76. for the total amount of \$800,000.00 for a new P.L. 93-638 contract to enter into an agreement with ADOT for the design and construction of a 1 mile frontage road in Canyon Day.

H5224200 – FAIR SR73 (3) Pedestrian Crossing: 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 for a new P.L. 93-638 to enter into an agreement with ADOT to provide Pedestrian Crossings on SR 73 at three locations in the Community of Whiteriver.

H5283100 – FAIR Trails Scoping Study: 2013 TTP funds in the amount of \$40,000.00, and 2014 TTP funds in the amount of \$10,000.00, for a total amount of \$50,000.00 for a new P.L. 93-638 contract to conduct public meetings, perform preliminary surveys, and evaluate alignments for proposed trails and walkways to be designed and constructed under FAIR Safety No.1.

H5289400 – FAIR Tribal Transportation Planning No. 3: 2013 IRR Transportation Planning funds in the amount of \$9,259.03; 2013 TTP Transportation Planning carryover funds in the amount of \$61,765.66; 2014 TTP Transportation Planning Funds in the amount of \$65,330.78; and 2014 TTP Construction funds in the amount of \$250,000.00, are to be added to existing P.L. 93-638 Transportation Planning Grant No. A12AV01358, for additional staff, office space, and equipment, required to provide transportation planning assistance and services needed to support the tribal transportation program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribe's share of 2014 TTP funds, in the amount of \$200,000, to be made available for use by the BIA Fort Apache Branch of Roads to perform routine road maintenance activities, identified in Appendix A to Subpart G of 25 CFR 170.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.


