



# **WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE**

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

## **(Approving Request for the Tribe to Host the 2015 Native Vision Camp)**

---

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in conjunction with Johns Hopkins University has conducted research projects for more than 30 years which aim to raise the level of health of all residents of the Reservation; and

**WHEREAS,** Johns Hopkins, in partnership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe has agreed to assist in efforts to find ways to raise the self-sufficiency of Indian communities to the highest possible level and to promote and celebrate all that is healthy and positive in the lives of our Native Youth; and

**WHEREAS,** Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp, scheduled for June 11-13, 2015 in Whiteriver, Arizona, will celebrate the 19<sup>th</sup> anniversary year of the Camp and the 7<sup>th</sup> year the White Mountain Apache Tribe has served as host; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council further finds that the Tribe, as host for the 2015 Native Vision Camp, should provide, as in years past, the following: *Port-a-johns, security provided by Tribal Police Dept for duration of camp, EMT's services for duration of camp, and Welcome Address/Farewell Ceremony and All-Star Basketball Game Presentations* during the 2015 Native Vision Camp to be hosted on the White Mountain Apache Tribe June 11-13, 2015;

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp, scheduled for June 11-13, 2015, is hereby approved.
2. In-kind support is hereby authorized for the above listed items and services.
3. Hon-Dah Resort is hereby requested to provide in-kind support required herein.
4. Public Works is hereby requested to provide in-kind support for Port-a-johns.
5. The Tribal Police Department is hereby requested to designate officers and provide in-kind security services during Camp. In the event that the Police Department cannot provide security services, Johns Hopkins shall also seek security from BIA.
6. EMS Department is hereby requested to designate personnel and provide in-kind Emergency services during Camp.
7. Authorizes that the Johns Hopkins Center for American Indian Health, in partnership with the NFL Players Association will serve as the coordinating group for the Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp, June 11-13, 2015 in Whiteriver, Arizona.
8. During the event, the area from the Alchesay High School football field turn-off to Highway 73 will be shut down.


**Resolution No. 02-2015-26**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **FEBRUARY 11, 2015** duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for, **ZERO** against, and **ONE** abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
