(Authorize Theodore Roosevelt School Board to Apply for School Improvement Grant and for 21st Century Grant)

WHEREAS, Theodore Roosevelt School requests grant applications submissions for the School Improvement Grant and 21st Century Grant, which are both competitive grants for schools that demonstrate the greatest need for the funds and the strongest commitment to use the funds to provide adequate resources in order to substantially raise the achievement of students in lowest-performing schools; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe and Theodore Roosevelt School to approve the grant application submissions requested by Theodore Roosevelt School.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the grant application submissions as requested by Theodore Roosevelt School.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 2015 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ONE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
