(Approval to Grant Tribal Relinquishment Request of Riley Blaine Burrell)

WHEREAS, Tribal Member, Riley Blaine Burrell, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment with Gila River Indian Community; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee reviewed and approved the relinquishment requests at a duly called meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee that the relinquishment from tribal membership be approved for Riley Blaine Burrell.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Riley Blaine Burrell, along with any and all privileges accorded to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe such as, but not limited to, hunting, fishing, and recreational privileges upon the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Riley Blaine Burrell from the membership rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 05, 2015, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ONE against with ONE abstaining by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

I, Crystal Burrell the parent of our child who is an enrolled member of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, under the age of 15 years, do hereby, of my free will, as an adult over the age of eighteen years, voluntarily and with full knowledge of making this decision, request the TRIBAL COUNCIL of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA, to release my/our child from the Tribal Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enable my/our child to enroll with the Gila River Indian Community.

Further, I understand that my child will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION; No home site or farmland assignments, or claim to have titles to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgment under the Indian Claims Commission Act.

Further, that I must remove from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation within ninety (90) days after the Resolution date accepting my child's relinquishment, any livestock in said child's name. I further understand, however, that my child may reapply for enrollment in the White Mountain Apache Tribe upon reaching the age of eighteen (18), but that the Tribal Council has total, nonreviewable discretion to deny or grant said reapplication.
