(Approval to Cover Burial Expenses for Kyra Kinney)

the Tribal Council has been advised that Kyra (Johnson) Kinney, daughter of former WHEREAS,

member of the Tribal Council, Mariddie Craig, passed away and that funeral

arrangements are pending; and

the Tribal Council extends its sincere sympathy to the Johnson and Kinney family; and WHEREAS,

WHEREAS, in recognition of former Councilwoman Craig's public service to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council finds that the Tribe should assume certain expenses

over and above those normally provided through the burial services account.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Treasurer to pay for the funeral expense for the decedent, Kyra Kinney, through the already budgeted burial expense account in the amount of \$1,500.00; with check to be issued directly to Mariddie Craig.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

> The foregoing resolution was on OCTOBER 12, 2015 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ONE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
