



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

**(Direct Shannon Tsoisie, Jessica Rudolfo, and Brenda Roberts
to Provide Plan of Action on Behalf of Cibecue Gymnasium)**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“WMAT”) acknowledges that many Tribal buildings are in a state of disrepair and specifically, the Cibecue Gymnasium, a venue for various events that benefits the community, requires attention and support from the Tribal Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, as the Division of Health is often eligible for grants, and the Planning Department is working on a master plan to move the WMAT forward, the Tribal Council depends on the respective employees to take every measure to further the best interests of the White Mountain Apache people and to further community interests; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds it in the best interest of the WMAT, to direct Shannon Tsoisie (Diabetes), Jessica Rudolfo (Health), and Brenda Roberts (Planning) to work together to bring forth a plan of action on behalf of the Tribal Council to renovate and restore the Cibecue Gymnasium for the benefit of the Cibecue community and greater White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Shannon Tsoisie, Jessica Rudolfo, and Brenda Roberts work together to create an action plan for restoring the Cibecue Gymnasium for the benefit of the Tribal Community of Cibecue and for the benefit of all Tribal members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that although the structure raises some concerns in the short-term, that Councilmen Alsenay and Beach shall take lead for Cibecue and organize a Thanksgiving Dinner to take place at the Cibecue Gym.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.


Resolution No. 11-2015-223
