



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## ( Authorizing a Memorandum of Agreement between the Division of Health Programs and the Whiteriver Unified School District )

**WHEREAS,** representatives from the Division of Health Programs presented to the Tribal Council requesting to establish a Memorandum of Agreement (“MOA”) between the Whiteriver Unified School District Health Department and the Division of Health/CHR Program; and

**WHEREAS,** the agreement will allow the school nurses to complete health screens, document and chart all data in the school district computer software; and

**WHEREAS,** the Division of Health Programs will coordinate and provide health education, disease prevention, fitness activities, teen pregnancy and substance abuse awareness to students upon collaboration with the school district; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest to approve the Memorandum of Agreement between the Division of Health Programs and the Whiteriver Unified School District.



**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Memorandum of Agreement between the Division of Health/CHR Programs and the Whiteriver Unified School District.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on DECEMBER 2, 2015 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
