

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorize Ivan Kitcheyan and Michelle Holden to renew the DUNS Number and Remove Emily Hernandez)

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the governing body that an administrative issue regarding the DUNS number (a 9-digit identifier for grant purposes) exists, and Emily Hernandez, a former employee has access and should be removed and the DUNS number must be renewed; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to authorize Ivan Kitcheyan and Michelle Holden to renew the DUNS number and to remove Emily Hernandez as an authorized representative as she no longer is employed with the Tribal government.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Ivan Kitcheyan and Michelle Holden to update/renew the DUNS number and information and to remove Emily Hernandez as an authorized user due to her recent resignation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **DECEMBER 2, 2015** duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for, **ZERO** against, and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
