

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

(Approval for White Mountain Apache Head Start to Submit an Extended Duration of Services Funding Application)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program provides valuable early childhood development services to the children of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, representatives from the Head Start Program presented and requested to the Tribal Council to submit an application for supplemental funds to extend the duration of services; and

WHEREAS, the extended duration funding available is to provide access to full day and longer months of school, in which the children will be in class for a total of 6 hours a day (8:30 – 2:30), five days a week for a total of 1020 hours for the 2016-2017 School Year scheduled to begin on August 15, 2016 through May 26, 2017, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concurs with the Head Start Program to submit and meet all requirements specified in the application.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Head Start Program to submit the extended duration funding application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JUNE 8, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ZERO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
