(Authorizing the Fair & Rodeo Office to Apply for the **Native American Activities Contribution Grant)**

funding for events within the Tribe and services for development are insufficient to meet the WHEREAS, needs of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

a funding opportunity exists in the form of the Freeport – McMoRan Copper & Gold Native WHEREAS, American Community Activities Contribution Grant Program that would enable the Tribe to supplement current funding to develop and enhance community activities and services for the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

the Fair and Rodeo Office presented a detailed proposal and budget for the second annual WHEREAS, Community Day Celebration event, scheduled for August 30, 2016; and

the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to authorize the Fair and Rodeo WHEREAS, Office to submit an application to Freeport-McMoran Copper & Gold as specified herein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Fair & Rodeo Office to prepare and submit an application to the Freeport - McMoran Copper & Gold Native American Community Activities Contribution grant program on behalf of the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 13, 2016 duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
