

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Proceeds from the Queen Pageant)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Queen is an officially recognized good willed ambassador for the White Mountain Apache Tribe with a yearly pageant that is held on conjunction with the annual White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair and Rodeo; and

WHEREAS, since the commencement of the annual festivities, all proceeds from pageants and Fair and Rodeo events have been submitted to the Business Office for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe and the Fair and Rodeo Office to reiterate the process for depositing all proceeds from the White Mountain Apache Tribe's annual queen pageant.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Fair and Rodeo Office to coordinate with the Central Business Office to ensure that audits and deposits are completed for the annual White Mountain Apache Queen pageant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a valid driver's license is not a pre-requisite for participating in the pageant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>AUGUST 17, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ELEVEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ZERO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
