

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorizing Arlene Beach to Receive Annual Leave Transfer)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe respects and supports family values and appreciates the fact that there are personal emergencies that come up that are beyond the control of the employees; and

**WHEREAS**, Arnold Beach Sr., District I Tribal Council Member, informed the Tribal Council of the need to transfer annual leave to his spouse, Arlene Beach, an employee of Hondah Casino; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of Arlene Beach and the Tribe to help during this time of need by allowing Arnold Beach, Sr., to transfer annual leave hours.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Arnold Beach, Sr., to transfer one hundred seventy hours of annual leave to Arlene Beach.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>SEPTEMBER 22, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>FOUR</u> for, <u>ONE</u> against, and <u>TWO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
