



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Budget Modification)

WHEREAS, The Tribal FY 13-14 budget was in need of modification; and

WHEREAS, the FY 13-14 budget was extended three months, effective from May 2017 until the end July 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the Sensitive Species Staff should be added to the budget continuation with modifications as explained by the Tribal Treasurer.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extended the Tribal FY 13-14 budget by three months effective May 2017 to the end of July 2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby added the Sensitive Species Staff to the budget continuation with modifications to be made by the Tribal Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 22, 2017 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
