



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

( Appointing Jarvis Davis to the Land Restoration Board )

- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council enacted the White Mountain Apache Tribe Land Restoration Code which provides for a seven-member Land Restoration Board, delegated to review and approve land restoration projects funded through the Land Restoration Fund; and
- WHEREAS**, there is currently a vacant position on the board membership and it has been recommended that Jarvis Davis be appointed as the District IV representative; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to appoint Jarvis Davis to the Land Restoration Board


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Jarvis Davis to serve on the Land Restoration Board.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 7, 2017 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
