

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorizing Burial of Non-Tribal Member Winifred Cromwell)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Winifred Cromwell, passed away and that funeral

arrangements are pending; and

WHEREAS, the Cromwell Family respectfully request that the Tribal Council authorize the deceased,

Winifred Cromwell, to be buried at the Canyon Day Cemetery in Whiteriver, Az; and

WHEREAS, although Winifred Cromwell, was not a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, she was

a long time resident of the Canyon Day Community, and further, her children are enrolled

members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the assistance provided herein is consistent with the culture and

tradition of White Mountain Apache and in sympathy to the family; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Family to bury the late Winifred Cromwell at the Canyon Day Cemetery, Whiteriver, Az.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 17, 2017</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ZERO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
