



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorizing Financial Assistance for Miss White Mountain Apache Queen)

WHEREAS, current reigning Miss White Mountain Apache Queen, Donita Machuse, presented to the governing body and requested financial assistance for representation at the Gathering of Nations event in Albuquerque, New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to provide financial assistance in the amount of seven hundred dollars (\$700.00), payable to Donita Machuse.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes financial assistance for Miss White Mountain Apache Queen, Donita Machuse, in the amount of seven hundred dollars (\$700.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 11, 2018 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and TWO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
