



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

## ( Returning all Central Tribal Employees to 80 Hours )

**WHEREAS,** Central Tribe's employees were mandated by resolution to reduce hours of operations from eighty hours (80) to seventy-two (72) or sixty-four (64) hours; and

**WHEREAS,** it was recommended that all Central Tribe's employees, funded through 01 account, be reinstated to eighty (80) hours; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to reinstate all Central Tribal employees, funded through 01 account, to eighty (80) hours, effective immediately.



**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates all Central Tribal employees, funded through 01 account, to eighty (80) hours, effective immediately.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 23, 2018 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, TWO against, and ONE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
