



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorizing Tsee Nanodoz Community Alliance Corporation, a Not-For-Profit Corporation Organized for the Benefits of the Residents of District III, to Operate on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation)

WHEREAS, members of East Fork, Seven Mile, and Turkey Creek communities, of District III, have established a 501(c)(3) called the Tsee Nanodoz Community Alliance Corporation, which is organized under the laws of the State of Arizona and includes a duly appointed board of directors; and

WHEREAS, Tsee Nanodoz Community Alliance does not sell goods or services, and so is exempt from acquiring a business license through the Tribe, but shall operate as a non-profit organization working on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, Tsee Nanodoz Community Alliance does not require any monetary assistance from the Tribe in order to start and maintain operations, but desires to apply for, manage, administer and obtain grants for the benefit of the communities of District III, geared at community development; and

WHEREAS, the needs of the communities of District III are great and the Tsee Nanodoz Community Alliance desires to coordinate, correlate, and cooperate with the Tribe for the betterment of its members, particularly those in District III.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the Tsee Nandoz Community Alliance to operate on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 10, 2019 duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
