**(Approving 2019 Fair and Rodeo Law Enforcement Budget
Under WMAT General 01 Account Fund)**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) is entrusted by the Tribe’s Constitution to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, and to regulate subordinate organizations for economic and other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair and Rodeo is an annual occurrence, typically at the last week of August and beginning September; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Police Department has requested assistance and support from outside agencies during the Fair weekend; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Police Department is requesting for the tribal government to approve the proposed 2019 Fair and Rodeo Law Enforcement Budget to pay for the lodging and meals for the officers during the 94th Annual White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair & Rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has consented to deputize the law enforcement agencies as White Mountain Apache law enforcement agents to enforce the laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a period not to exceed eight (8) days; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests directs the Office of the Tribal Treasurer and Controller to make funds available to pay for items outlined within the 2019 Fair and Rodeo Law Enforcement Budget under the WMAT General 01 Account Fund.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the 2019 Fair and Rodeo Law Enforcement Budget as presented to the general assembly of the tribal council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer and Controller to make funds available under the General 01 Account fund for the needs of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Department during the 94th Annual White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair and Rodeo as proposed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal



Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JULY 10, 2019** duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for, **ZERO** against, and **ONE** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
