

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorizing Interment of Non-Tribal Member Alex Ruben Rodriguez's Ashes on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation)

- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation ("Constitution") provides, at Article IV, Section 1(a) that the Tribal Council ("Council") shall exercise the power "To represent the tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe"; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has been advised that Alex Ruben Rodriguez, spouse of Tribal member DeJean (Altaha) Rodriguez passed away and that funeral arrangements are pending; and
- WHEREAS, The decedent's family requests that the Tribal Council authorize interment of the deceased's ashes at the Mourning Dove Cemetery in Cedar Creek on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- **WHEREAS**, Although Mr. Rodriguez was not a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council finds that the request made herein should be granted; and
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the family to bury the decedent, Alex Ruben Rodriguez, at the Mourning Dove Cemetery.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
