



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

**(Accepting Federal Aviation Administration Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act Airport Grants for Whiteriver and Cibecue Airports in the Total Amount of \$18,000.00)**

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**WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(j) that the Tribal Council (“Council”) shall exercise the power, “To accept grants and donations from any person, State, or the United States”; and

**WHEREAS,** As part of its Airport improvement Program, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Department of Transportation applied for and was awarded two \$9,000.00 grants designated 21-06-28 (the “Grants”) funded by allocations provided to the Federal Aviation Administration by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act; and

**WHEREAS,** The Grants are to be used for the Whiteiver and Cibecue airports, and require formal acceptance by the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** The Council finds that accepting these two grants will obtain needed funds for the Whiteriver and Cibecue airports and is in the best interest of the Tribe and its members.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the 21-06-28 Federal Aviation Administration Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act Airport Grants, in the amount of \$9,000.00 each for the Whiteriver and Cibecue airports.



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 25, 2021 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, ZERO against, and ONE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
