



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## A Sovereign Tribal Nation

### **(Authorizing Changes to the Certificate of Authorization with Wells Fargo)**

---

**WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(i) that the Tribal Council (“Council”) shall exercise the power, “To manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe...”; and

**WHEREAS,** Wells Fargo bank requires updated signatures when new public officials come into office; and

**WHEREAS,** The following individuals now hold public office and should be reflected on the Certificate of Indian Tribal Entity and Certificate of Incumbency:

- Kasey Velasquez – Chairman;
- Jerome Kasey III – Vice Chairman;
- Arnold Beach – Dist 1;
- Travis Tessay Sr – Dist 1;
- Jerold Altaha – Dist 2;
- Renaldo Dazen – Dist 2;

- Annette Tenjieth – Dist 3;
- Gary Alchesay – Dist 4;
- Mariddie Craig – Dist 4;
- Verna Westover – Dist 4.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the changes to the Certificate of Indian Tribal Entity and Certificate of Incumbency to make it consistent with those names listed above.



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 5, 2022 duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
