



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Fair and Rodeo Commissioners)

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(s) that the Tribal Council (“Council”) shall exercise the power, “To regulate its own procedures, to appoint subordinate committees, commissions, boards, advisory or otherwise...”; and

WHEREAS, The Council appoints and Rodeo Commission, to serve on a volunteer basis; and

WHEREAS, The Council finds, at this time, that appointing the following individuals to serve on the Fair and Rodeo Commission will assist in a successful 2022 Tribal Fair and Rodeo, and is in the best interests of the Tribe and its members:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following individuals are hereby appointed to the Tribe’s Fair and Rodeo Commission, effective immediately and until subsequent Council action: Shyanne Early-Duane; Gary Hill; Joel Hernandez; Monte George; Dallas Baha; Darlea Maya; Renell Williams; Rose M. Kasey; Marcia Altaha; and Ricardo Velasquez.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the previous Fair and Rodeo Commissioners, not named above, are hereby excused with thanks for their contributions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

Resolution No. 05-2022-135

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 23, 2022 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ZERO against, and TWO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
