



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Tribal Employment Rights Office Commission Members)

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(s) that the Tribal Council (“Council”) shall exercise the power, “To regulate its own procedures, to appoint subordinate committees, commissions, boards, advisory or otherwise...”; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 09-2012-134 established a Tribal Employment Rights Office (“TERO”) Commission, to provide administrative review of TERO decisions, including sanctions and other disciplinary actions; and

WHEREAS, The Council finds, at this time, that the following individuals should be appointed to the TERO/TAP Commission, effective immediately and until subsequent Council action:

- Ora Henry;
- Harpert Sanchez;
- Milford Cosen;
- Amy George; and
- Vino Burnette Sr.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Ora Henry, Harpert Sanchez, Milford Cosen, Amy George and Vino Burnette Sr. to serve as the Tribe’s TERO/TAP Commissioners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all previous commissioners, unnamed above, are hereby excused from the TERO/TAP Commission and thanked for their hard work and contributions to the Tribe’s TERO/TAP Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Resolution No. 05-2022-141

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 23, 2022 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
