



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Waylon Truax to Serve as the Program Manager for the Tribe's Land Operations Department)

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(s) that the Tribal Council ("Council") shall exercise the power, "To... appoint subordinate committees, commissions, boards, advisory or otherwise, Tribal officials and employees not provided for in this constitution, and to regulate subordinate organizations for economic and other purposes"; and

WHEREAS, Waylon Truax has served with distinction for some time as Acting Program Manager, after the departure of his predecessor; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that permanently appointing Waylon Truax to serve as Program Manager will continue to provide the Tribe with the experience, expertise and talent it needs to fulfil this important role, and is in the best interests of the Tribe and its members.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Waylon Truax is hereby permanently appointed to serve as Program Manager for the Tribe's Land Operations Department, effective immediately and until subsequent Council action.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JANUARY 31, 2023 duly adopted by a vote of TEN for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
