



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Rencher Paxson, Larold Pinal, and Aaron Tate to the Serve on the KNNB Apache Radio Board)

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(s) that the Tribal Council (“Council”) shall exercise the power, “To... appoint subordinate...boards...”; and

WHEREAS, There exist several vacancies on the KNNB Apache Radio Board; and

WHEREAS, Council finds, at this time that the appointing Rencher Paxson, Larold Pinal and Aaron Tate to the Board of Directors of KNNB Apache Radio is in the best interest of the Tribe and its members.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Rencher Paxson, Larold Pinal and Aaron Tate are hereby appointed to serve on the Board of Directors for KNNB Apache Radio, effective immediately and until subsequent action by the Tribal Council.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 3, 2023 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, TWO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
